Things to Note	
	TAKE PHOTOS of EVERYTHING - When you get home you can note things with photos while still fresh in your mind.
	Neighborhood overall appearance.
	Look over yard and home. Is it workable for your plans? Enough space? Walk entire property.
	Does home exterior or interior need painting or repairs?
	See any staining on exterior at gutters, corners etc. Sign that water is not draining properly. Same with interior.
	Is flooring in good condition or need replacing?
	Are appliances included? Are they running and in use?
	Does home have utilities you want? Gas, Electric, water, sewer or septic?
	See any possible structural issues like a sinking corner? Look at beams in basement if present, any large cracks or cut outs for ductwork etc? Could be a sign of structural issues.
	Note any wall or floor tiles cracked or lifted up. Could be just damage, could be structural.
	Look at roof lines. Do they sink or bow? Sign of possible structural issues.
